Welcome to IDEA MATH. We are pleased to have you join our program and look forward to working with you.

General Expectations

At IDEA MATH, we strive to create an environment that will foster both personal and intellectual growth for all of our students. Thus, we expect that students will respect anyone they encounter during our program. This includes the instructors, IDEA MATH staff and other students. IDEA MATH students should also respect dining hall staff, facilities managers and other personnel who may or may not be a part of the IDEA MATH staff. Students are should take good care of the schools facilities and stay within the designated areas for IDEA MATH students. Students must cooperate with adult supervision and attend all classes and activities.

The well-being of our students is our biggest priority at IDEA MATH. We ask that students observe basic rules of physical safety and practice proper hygiene. We also expect that no student will engage in activities that threaten health, safety or well-being of themselves or of others.

Discipline

We handle student discipline situations on a case-by-case basis. Generally, a student could face a discipline case (and possible dismissal) from our program if his or her presence threatens the health or safety of his or her self, or others at our program.

Some reasons for which a student may face a discipline case include:

- 1.) Stealing or vandalizing property.
- 2.) Engaging in bullying, hazing or other harassing behavior
- 3.) Not cooperating with adult supervision.
- 4.) Threatening others.
- 5.) Possessing or using tobacco, alcohol or other drugs.
- 6.) Being in restricted areas of campus or leaving campus without the permission of the IDEA MATH staff or of campus staff.
- 7.) Leaving the dorm without IDEA MATH staff permission after check-in
- 8.) Possessing any of the prohibited items listed below.

Prohibited Items

The following items must not be brought to our program:

- 1.) Weapons of any kind (includes pocket knives, martial arts devices, mace and electric stun guns).
- 2.) Any flame-producing device (including matches, lighters and firecrackers).
- 3.) Pets of any kind.
- 4.) Halogen lamps, refrigerators or cooking devices.
